ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE AND ESTIMATE OF REVENUES OF THE CITY OF ATHENS, ILLINOIS, FOR THE CORPORATE YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2024, AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2025.

An ordinance appropriating for all corporate purposes of the City of Athens, Menard County, Illinois for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2024, and ending April 30, 2025.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Athens, Menard County, Illinois:

SECTION 1. That the amount hereinafter set forth, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law, and as may be needed or deemed necessary to defray all expenses and liabilities of the municipality be the same are hereby appropriated for corporate purposes of the City of Athens, Menard County, Illinois, as hereinafter specified for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2024 and ending April 30, 2025.

SECTION 2. That the appropriation herein made for any purpose shall be regarded as the maximum amounts to be expended under the respective appropriation accounts and shall not be construed as a commitment, agreement, obligation or liability of the City of Athens, and such appropriation being subject to further approval as to expenditure thereof by the City Council.
